# Krog Street Tunnel Stormwater Project Phase II

# Krog Street Tunnel Stormwater Project

The purpose of this project is to replace and upsize the existing storm drain system to mitigate flooding in the Krog Street Tunnel during rain events.

# Krog Street Tunnel Stormwater Project

Phase I of the project consists of installing new inlets and stormwater pipeline in the vicinity of the Krog Street and Dekalb Avenue intersection.

Phase II will be a connection point on the existing storm pipe system and will include capacity relief for the storm line that runs under the tunnel.

# Krog Street Tunnel Stormwater Project

## Phase II

Phase II of the installation of the new storm drain system in the Krog Street Tunnel will consist of minimizing the disruption to the community.

The pipe will be installed using a trenchless method called hand-mined tunneling.

The tunneling effort will create a utility tunnel that will hold the new storm drain piping as well as a new 16-inch water main that will replace the existing water main.

# Krog Street Tunnel Stormwater Project

## Phase II

A shaft will be excavated to allow the new utility tunnel to be completed. This will require Estoria Street to always remain closed to thru/all traffic for the duration of this project.


The utility tunnel will be installed at Dekalb Avenue and will connect to the Krog Street phase I work.

# Krog Street Tunnel Stormwater Project

## Phase II


Once the utility tunnel is complete, the new storm piping and water line will be installed inside of the tunnel.

The storm and water lines will be tested, and the final connections will be made at the intersection of Dekalb Avenue and Krog Street, as well as Estoria Street/Wylie Street and Krog Street.









# Restoration

Once the restoration work is complete, the shaft on Estoria Street will be backfilled and the road will be restored and reopened.

All asphalt, concrete, and landscaping will be restored at the completion of the project.

# Community Impact

The work along Wylie Street will be completed with a road closure to thru traffic from Short Street to Krog Street and Estoria Street. The work at the intersection of Krog Street and Estoria Street will be completed with a lane closure.

All businesses and residences will be accessible during construction.

Roads will be accessible for emergency vehicles, mail, and trash services.

Any work that requires a temporary traffic closure on Krog Street will be done at night.
